LEVEL 1

BOOK Alfred's Basic Group Piano Course Book 1

STUDENTS WILL LEARN

- Playing posture & proper piano technique
- Steady beat & basic rhythms (quarter note, half note, whole note)
- Pitch (high & low)
- Black key groups & white keys
- Dynamics (forte, piano, mezzo-forte)
- Playing positions (middle C & C position)
- Time signature (4/4)
- Famous pieces, such as "Old MacDonald," "Merrily We Roll Along" and "Marry Had a Little Lamb"

LEVEL 2

Prerequisites: Completion of Level 1 within six months of the start of the Level 2 class **OR** recommendation by the Program Liaison for students with prior musical background that have not taken the level 1 class. Email classes@omahacm.org for class placement.

- · Quarter rest & whole rest and ties
- Treble clef & bass clef
- Grand staff
- Playing positions (middle C & C)

- Time signatures (4/4 and 3/4)
- Dynamics (forte, piano, mezzo-forte)
- Articulation (legato)
- Ensemble playing opportunities

- Quarter rest, half rest, whole rest and ties
- Treble clef & bass clef
- Grand staff
- · Incomplete measures, fermata, ritardando
- Sharps & flats
- Playing positions (middle C, C, & G)
- Time signatures (4/4, 3/4, & 2/4)
- Dynamics (forte, piano, mezzo-forte, crescendo, diminuendo)
- Articulation (legato, staccato, accent)
- Intervals (2nd/3rd/4th/5th)
- Tempo marks
- Ensemble playing opportunities
